# **Assam Skill University**



## **About Assam Skill University**

The Assam Legislative Assembly passed the Assam Skill University Bill -2020 in September 2020 to establish Assam Skill University (ASU) in accordance with the regulations of the University Grants Commission, Government of India. The Assam Skill University Act-2020 came into force w.e.f. 4th August, 2021.

The State Government also foresee ASU to cater for the needs of students; Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) and higher education institutions; and industries in neighboring countries, which face similar challenges in skills education and training, and with which the state has long-standing relationships. ASU is being set up at Mangaldoi (Darang district), located about 70 kilometers east of Guwahati. Mangaldoi is connected by National Highway 15. The main campus at Mangaldoi is under construction over a plot of land measuring 83 acres (250 Bigha) and is likely to be ready for occupation in July, 2025.

Meanwhile, a city campus is established at Gopinath Nagar, Guwahati within the ITI-Guwahati campus. The University has commenced the sessions for the academic year 2024-25 from the city campus. The main campus at Mangoldoi will be operational from academic session 2025-2026.
