

1. Counselling Procedure for 3-Year Diploma Programs

Offered in: Digital Manufacturing Technology, Electric Vehicle Technology, and Mechanical Engineering.

1.1. Eligibility and Merit Criteria

- **Minimum average marks in HSLC or equivalent examination:**
 - General Category: 40%
 - Other Categories: 35%
- **Merit List** will be prepared based on the Average Marks obtained in **Science and Mathematics** in HSLC.
- In case of a tie in the average marks of Science and Mathematics, the **overall HSLC percentage** will be considered for shortlisting.

1.2. Counselling Schedule

- First Counselling: 02 July 2025
- Second Counselling (for vacant seats): 10 July 2025

1.3. Process of Counselling

- Counselling will be held for all three branches (DDMT, Mechanical and Electric Vehicle) together.
- Students will be called as per the common merit list.
- Students will be allowed to choose the branch(s) as per their choice depending upon their application and availability of seats.
- On 02 July 2025, all shortlisted candidates will be invited for the first round of counselling.
- Admission will first be offered to candidates from the General Merit List for **33 seats** (11 per branch).
- Once these 33 seats are filled, candidates from the reserved categories will be considered for admission.
- For each seat, a candidate will be called up to three times. If the candidate fails to respond, the opportunity will be passed to the next eligible candidate in line.

1.4. Reservation Policy (Total 90 Seats: 30 intake capacity per branch)

- Separate merit lists will be published for each reserved category across all three branches.
- Once the allocated seats for a category and branch are filled, further counselling will not be conducted for that branch-category combination.

1.5. Policy for Filling Vacant Reserved Seats

- Vacant OBC, SC, EWS, and PH seats will be filled from the General Merit List.
- Vacant ST-P seats will be filled from the ST-H list, and vice versa.
- Combined vacant seats of ST-P and ST-H, if any, will then be filled from the General Merit List.

1.6. Documents Required During Counselling

- HSLC Admit Card, Marksheets, and Certificate
- Age limit proof (minimum 16 years as on 31/12/2025, no upper age limit)
- Gap Certificate (if applicable)

- Permanent Residence Certificate (PRC) to be submitted within 2 months from admission.
- EWS certificate must be valid up to 31/03/2025 and admitted candidate has to submit the renewed EWS certificate after taking admission.
- NCL certificate must be valid up to the date of the admission.

2. Counselling Procedure for 4-Years B. Tech Program and Five Years Integrated Postgraduate Program

Programs Offered:

- Computer Science and Engineering with Honours in Cyber Security
- Computer Science and Engineering with Honours in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning
- Civil Engineering with Honours in Digital Transformation in Construction
- Five Years Integrated Postgraduate offered in Food Technology

2.1. Eligibility and Merit Criteria

- **Minimum average marks in HS (Science) or equivalent examination:**
 - General Category: 45%
 - Other Categories: 40%
- **For B.Tech Program (Three Merit Lists):**
 - **ASUEE for 20 seats:** Merit based on the total marks obtained in:
 - ASUEE (weightage 80%)
 - Average of Physics and Mathematics (weightage 20%)
 - **CEE for 7 seats**
 - **JEE for 3 seats**
- **For Five Years Integrated Master of Science in Food Technology:** Merit List will be prepared based on the Marks obtained in **ASUEE**.

2.2. Counselling Schedule

- ASUEE: 22 June 2025
- First Counselling: 01 July 2025

- Second Counselling (for vacant seats): 08 July 2025

2.3. Process of Counselling

- Counselling will be held for all three BTech programs together and in parallelly for Five Years Integrated Postgraduate Program in Food Technology.
- Students will be called for counselling as per the common merit list.
- Students will be allowed to choose the branch(s) in BTech program as per their choice depending upon their application and availability of seats.
- On 01 July 2025, all shortlisted candidates through ASUEE, CEE and JEE will be invited for the first round of counselling.
- Admission will first be offered to candidates from the General Merit List followed by reserved categories will be considered for admission.
- For the seat, a candidate will be called up to three times within the stipulated time period allotted. If the candidate fails to respond, the opportunity will be passed to the next eligible candidate in line.

2.4. Reservation Policy

- Total allotted seats for all the three B Tech programs is 90 (30 seats in each B'Tech program).
- Admission shall be conducted in accordance with the reservation norms as follows for three B Tech Programs:

i. For ASUEE (There are 20 seats from ASUEE for each program with a total of 60 seats)

- Vacant ST-P seats will be filled from the ST-H list, and vice versa.
- Combined vacant seats of ST-P and ST-H, if any, will then be filled from the General Merit List.

- Age limit (minimum 18 years as on 31/12/2025, no upper age limit)
- Gap Certificate (if applicable)
- Permanent Residence Certificate (PRC) to be submitted within 2 months from admission.
- EWS certificate must be valid up to 31/03/2025 and admitted candidate has to submit the renewed EWS certificate after taking admission.
- NCL certificate must be valid up to the date of the admission.

3. Counselling Procedure for 2-Years Master of Travel and Tourism Management (MTTM) Program

3.1. Eligibility and Merit Criteria

- Minimum aggregate marks in Graduation (Bachelor's degree in any discipline):**
 - General Category: 45%
 - Other Categories: 40%
- A List will be prepared based on the Marks obtained in **ASUEE** for Personal Interview (PI).
- Depending on the marks of ASUEE and PI, the final merit list will be prepared.

3.3. Process of Counselling

- Students will be called for counselling as per the common merit list.
- On 04 July 2025, all shortlisted candidates through ASUEE will be invited for the first round of counselling.
- All the 30 seats of 2 years MTTM program (including the reserved category) will be filled up from the ASUEE short listed candidates.
- Admission will first be offered to candidates from the General Merit List followed by reserved categories will be considered for admission.
- For each seat, a candidate will be called up to three times. If the candidate fails to respond, the opportunity will be passed to the next eligible candidate in line.

- Vacant ST-P seats will be filled from the ST-H list, and vice versa.
- Combined vacant seats of ST-P and ST-H, if any, will then be filled from the General Merit List.

- EWS certificate must be valid up to 31/03/2025 and admitted candidate has to submit the renewed EWS certificate after taking admission.
- NCL certificate (OBC/MOBC) must be valid up to the date of the admission.
