MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called the "MoU") is made the of the month of July, 2024 between:

The Assam Skill University, a Government of Assam University established under "The Assam Skill University Act-2020" with its main campus at Mangaldoi, Darrang, Assam and City Campus at ITI-Guwahati Campus, Gopinath Nagar, Guwahati-781016 (herein also called ASU, which the expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) or the First Party

AND

Assam Road Research & Training Institute, Fatasil Ambari, Guwahati-781025, registered as Society under the administrative control of Public Works Roads Department, Government of Assam in accordance with Registration of Societies Act XXI of 1860, having its office at Fatasil Ambari, Guwahati Assam, on 3rd October, 2016 (herein also called ARR&TI, which the expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns) or the Second Party.

WHEREAS

- The First Party has requested the Second Party to provide its laboratory facility to develop the skill of youths in road construction technology as defined in this MoU (hereinafter called the "Facilities").
- (b) the Second Party has agreed to provide the laboratory facility on the terms set forth in this MoU.

NOW THEREFORE the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

- Laboratory facilities for tests and physical demonstrations required as part of each certificate course of ASU on "Road Construction Technology" for three batches, each consisting of not more than 25 students for a duration covering the tests/procedures in Annexure-A or a maximum of 15 days whichever is less, to be provided by ARR&TI. The scope inter alia includes the following:
 - The First Party will send the students from the Department of Civil, School of Manufacturing & Constructions for laboratory tests and practical demonstration to the Second Party laboratories as part of its certificate course program on "Road Construction Technology".
